Dr Decker gave a beautiful presentation on the strengths and weaknesses of an appliance system, how to troubleshoot various clinical areas and showed many cases he had learned from with a self-critical approach and what he would do differently today. This hugely benefits our members and the study club was full to capacity.

At the time of going to print the feedback is still coming in, but so far over 90% of the delegates have rated the event as 'excellent'."

The evening also benefited a fantastic cause, raising £320 for CLAPA – BLOS' nominated charity. This is the first time a donation has ever been made by the Society to such a worthy cause.

For those who couldn't make the trip to London, the presentation was recorded and will be shared with BLOS members. This again is the first undertaking of its kind by BLOS.
